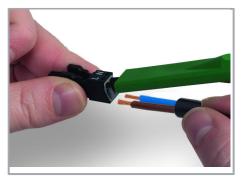


- 1. Strip length, outer insulation = 30 mm (2-pole), 37 mm (3-pole), 45 mm (4- and 5-pole)

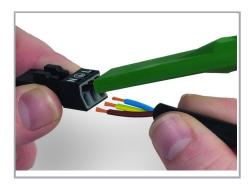

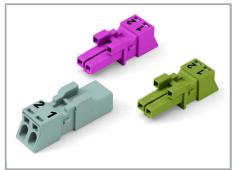

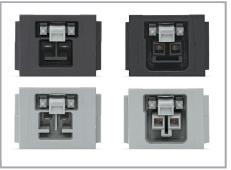


B-coded connectors with different colors can be plugged together.

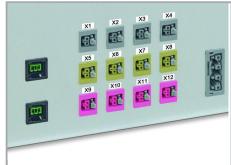
Important note:
